

MB Power (Madhya Pradesh) Limited Installs Street Lights from Jaitahari Chowk to Plant Gate No. 2

Date: 18.04.2025, Jaitahari – In a continued effort to ensure the convenience and safety of local residents, the CSR department of Hindustan Power has taken another significant step. The company has installed approximately 40 streetlights along the 1-kilometer stretch from Jaitahari Chowk to Plant Gate No. 2.

The installation was carried out adhering strictly to technical standards to ensure adequate illumination for the public. Each streetlight has been installed at a height of 7.5 meters, with a spacing of about 25 meters between poles to maximize lighting efficiency and coverage.

An inauguration ceremony was organized to unveil the newly illuminated road, now named **'Gaurav Path.'** The event was graced by Mr. Anil Gupta, former Vice Chairman of the Vindhya Development Authority, as the Chief Guest.
